Purpose of the Board or Committee	<p>The Sustainability Committee is responsible for overseeing the development and implementation of ICAEW's strategy and policies on sustainability.</p> <p>Its role includes: identifying aspects of sustainability that are relevant to ICAEW members or to ICAEW's public interest role; reviewing ICAEW consultation responses and representations on sustainability matters; and overseeing the provision of sustainability information, guidance and thought leadership to members and other stakeholders. Each committee member was asked to indicate the Sustainable Development Goal(s) that they are most passionate about – these are indicated under each of their profiles below.</p> <p>The Sustainability Committee comprises mainly ICAEW members, drawn from accountancy firms, businesses, NGOs and academia.</p> <p>Committee members are appointed for three year terms, renewable up to a maximum of six years.</p> <p>The Sustainability Committee's Terms of Reference can be found here.</p>
