Nominations for the Committee

If you want to:

- have a say in what we offer to our members locally we're interested in new initiatives and people to put them in place;
- make decisions about how the district society uses its resources; and
- be part of your local district society team find out about the committee your knowledge, expertise and drive can be put to good use.
- 1. Under the Society's rules, nomination of candidates for election or re-election to the Committee at an Annual General Meeting has to be made by notice in writing:
 - (a) signed by not less than TWO members of the district society;
 - (b) received by the president no later than 18 April 2022; and
 - (c) accompanied by intimation in writing from each candidate of his/her willingness to serve if elected or re-elected.
- 2. The following six members of the Committee retire by rotation at the 2022 Annual General Meeting in accordance with amended Rule 7:
 - Clive Bawden Tracey James Khuram Javed Chris Key Ben Powell Vipul Sheth

Clive, Tracey, Khuram, Chris, Ben and Vipul all wish to seek re-election.

 There will be 14 vacancies available at the Annual General Meeting on Monday 16 May 2022. Nominations for election, supported by a minimum of two members of ICAEW Birmingham and West Midlands, are requested and must be received by the president c/o <u>linda.conway@icaew.com</u> not later than 18 April 2022.

If more nominations are received than there are vacancies on the Committee, a list of nominations and voting papers shall be sent out to the members not less than fourteen days before the Annual General Meeting.

Nominations for the Independent Examiner

4. Nominations must be in writing and deposited with the president c/o <u>linda.conway@icaew.com</u> not later than 18 April 2022.

Neither a member of the committee nor a partner of the treasurer shall be eligible for election or reelection to the office of Independent Examiner.
