PRIORITY OBJECTIVES

1. LISTEN

2. CONNECT

We will communicate regularly, clearly, and appropriately with members via a range of channels / platforms (such as monthly e-newsletters and social media). Where possible we will explore ways to use (and promote the use of) new technology to engage with members in all areas.

We will create a welcoming and inclusive environment at all ICAEW Scotland events, so that members always feel confident and comfortable engaging with staff and fellow members, and that they are fully **supported** by ICAEW Scotland.

We will help members **connect** with the Institute at national, international, and local level, creating events, resources and communications which ensure that our members are **engaged** and always **supported**. Beyond ICAEW Scotland, we will develop and nurture **connections** with the wider business community and other key stakeholders in Scotland and **engage** with them as appropriate to **represent** both members in Scotland and ICAEW in general.

3. RESPOND

Our process is not set-in stone and will evolve to meet the changing needs of our members – in response to their feedback we will continue to explore ways to make the most of new technology, work to create events that reflect their needs, and ensure they can access the support and resources they need throughout their member journey.
