

Please update your Self Assessment tax return with final figures

We're writing to remind you that your Income Tax Self Assessment return for the year ended 5 April 2025 included one or more provisional figures.

We understand you sometimes need to use provisional figures. But it's important to replace them with final, accurate figures as soon as you have them.

Updating your return on time means we won't have to open an enquiry, and you won't have to pay interest on any tax you may owe.

If you've already updated your return you don't need to do anything. If you haven't, please take the following action.

What you need to do by [insert 30+5 days from date of letter issue]

1. Check the provisional figures in your return for year ended 5 April 2025.
2. If the final figures are different, amend your return by entering them. Go to GOV.UK and search 'self assessment'. Then choose 'If you need to change your return'.
3. If your provisional figures turned out to be accurate, amend your return by removing the tick in box 20.

If you don't amend your return, we may open an enquiry into your tax affairs.
