

Please update your Self Assessment tax return with final figures

We're writing to you about your Self Assessment return for the tax year ended 5 April 2025. On your return, you included the figures shown below.

Box number	Amount
Box number from data file	Amount (pounds only) from data file

We believe these may be rounded figures rather than exact figures. We understand you may have needed to use provisional figures to file on time. But it's important to (both):

- show this by ticking box 20 in the return
- replace the figures with final, accurate figures as soon as you have them.

Amending your return on time means we won't have to open an enquiry, and you won't have to pay interest on any tax you may owe.

If the figures in your return are accurate, or you've already updated your return, you don't need to do anything.

What you need to do by [35 days from date of letter issue]

- 1 Check any rounded figures in your return for the tax year ended 5 April 2025.
- 2 Amend your return with the final figures. Go to GOV.UK and search 'Self Assessment'. Then choose 'If you need to change your return'.

If you don't amend your return, we may open an enquiry to check if it's accurate.
