# Doctoral bursary opportunities – from the Chartered Accountants’ Livery Charity

## How to apply for our latest PhD Bursary

The Trustees are keen to continue to encourage ICAEW Members to pursue careers as academics in accountancy through the Bursary scheme.

## Eligibility

Applicants must already be members of the ICAEW (ACA or FCA qualified) and have a good honours degree or other equivalent qualification. The quality and contribution of the applicant’s planned research, their commitment to doctoral level study and their intention to pursue an academic career will all be taken into account. The institutions at which students plan to study must be recognised UK universities.

Each year the search for new applicants begins in the first quarter when the opportunity is promoted by the ICAEW.

Applicants must complete and submit a Bursary Application Form by 7th June 2022, after which a distinguished panel of academics comprising Professors Christopher Humphrey (Chair, far left), University of Manchester, Giovanna Michelon, University of Bristol, and Penelope Tuck, University of Birmingham, together with Andrew Pianca, a Trustee of the Charity, will invite short-listed candidates for interview, on 28th June 2022.



The panel will then recommend to the Trustees the applicants who they believe merit the award.
