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1 Summary

1.1 Introduction

The suitability of accounting software for each particular user will always be dependent upon that user's individual requirements. These requirements should therefore always be fully considered before software is acquired. The quality of the software developers or suppliers should also be considered at the onset.

1.2 Fundamentally, good accounting software should:

- Be capable of supporting the accounting functions for which it was designed.
- Provide facilities to ensure the completeness, accuracy, confidentiality and continued integrity of these accounting functions.
- Be effectively supported and maintained.

It is also desirable that good accounting software should:

- Be easy to learn, understand and operate.
- Make best practical use of available resources.
- Accommodate limited changes to reflect specific user requirements.

It is essential, when software is implemented, for appropriate support and training to be available.

2 Approach to evaluation

2.1 Objective

To evaluate TAS Books for Accountants Version 8 against a set of criteria developed by the ICAEW to ensure that the software meets the requirements of Good Accounting Software, as laid down in the summary.

2.2 Approach and Work performed

In order to effectively evaluate TAS Books for Accountants Version 8, a product specialist from the TAS Software completed the detailed questionnaire and provided it to the evaluator to examine. As this software is based around TAS Books 3, that is already ICAEW accredited, TAS Software supplied the evaluator with a copy of the software to test. The evaluator loaded the software onto a computer in his office and ran the various aspects of the software to check the answers and to confirm their validity. The questions were individually reviewed and commented on and the majority of assessments were confirmed.

The evaluator discussed the assessments with a member of TAS Software staff in order to clarify certain points. In the event of disagreement between TAS Software and the evaluator, the evaluator's decision was taken as final and the response changed accordingly.

TAS Books for Accountants Version 8, was used throughout the evaluation. The evaluation covered the fully integrated sales, purchase and general ledgers and

where appropriate sales order processing, sales invoicing, purchase order processing and stock software, separate reports have not been prepared for each ledger. Instead a composite report has been prepared with references made to the appropriate ledger as necessary.

When the evaluation had been completed, the responses were completed by the evaluator and a draft copy sent to the ICAEW for review before completion of the final report.

2.3 Software/hardware utilised

The software was run on an IBM portable with a Pentium III 644 MHz processor with 256Mb RAM and a 18.6Mb hard disk. The operating system was Microsoft XP Pro version 2002 service pack 2 and the software used throughout was TAS Books for Accountants Version 8.

2.4 Report structure

The report has been broken down into its main constituents in the contents page. The evaluation questionnaire was provided by the ICAEW and has been used without alteration or amendment.

3 Matters to consider before purchase

3.1 General overview

TAS claim to follow a rigorous design, development and testing procedure and allow their customers to participate in determining the future requirements and final testing of products. They aim to release a new version of their accounting software every 12 to 18 months.

3.2 Supplier background

TAS Software was formed in 1989 and was originally based in Epsom but relocated to Newcastle after being acquired by Sage (Ltd) UK in 2001. TAS Software now operates as a division within Sage. TAS claim that their software's Account Processor and Software technologies broke new ground in making computerised accounting easier to use. To date they have won more than 24 awards, recommendations and accreditation. They currently have 40,000 customers throughout the UK & Eire.

3.3 Product background and Suitability for user

TAS BOOKS for Accountants Version 8 is a program designed specifically for Accountants and Bookkeepers that runs under the Windows user interface. This system has been developed from the first versions of TAS BOOKS launched in 1989.

The program allows Accountants and bookkeepers to import and edit client data sets from all levels of TAS Books and to create new data sets through one program interface.

3.4 Typical implementation

TAS Market research and customer data analysis indicate that the large majority of TAS BOOKS users are smaller SMEs with up to 9 employees but they do

have larger SME customers who employ up to 100 employees and some use the multi-user version of TAS BOOKS. A number of these customers are accountants or bookkeepers, both as standard end user customers and also as members of the TAS Accountants Club.

3.5 Vertical applications

Payroll, CIS and Sage Accounts Production.

3.6 Software and hardware specifications

3.6.1 Development environment

TAS uses Visual Basic in its development environment.

3.6.2 Server platforms

TAS recommends using Windows Server 2003 for Multi-User applications.

3.6.3 Databases

The TAS Books range uses Pervasive V10.10.

3.6.4 Operating software

System requirements

- Microsoft Windows 2000, Windows XP (recommended) or Windows Vista
- Microsoft .NET v2 framework (this is included on the program CD)
- Microsoft Internet Explorer v6 or higher (this is included on the program CD)
- Adobe Acrobat Reader v6 or higher (this is included on the program CD)

3.6.5 Protocols

Standard TCP/IP is utilised to communicate between the clients and the server.

3.6.6 Minimum client PC specification

Minimum hardware requirements

- A PC with a 1GHz processor
- At least 256Mb of RAM.
- A hard disk with at least 500MB of free space
- A CD-ROM Drive
- A monitor with 1024x768 resolution and 24-bit colour
- An Internet connection

Recommended hardware requirements

- A PC with a 2Ghz processor
- At least 512Mb of RAM
- A hard disk with at least 500MB of free space

- A CD-ROM Drive
- A monitor with 1280x1024 resolution and 32-bit colour
- A broadband Internet connection

Performance will be improved with higher specification computers.

3.6.7 Support and maintenance

TAS provide customer services to handle all customer contact including: Software Support – handling incoming queries by telephone, fax and email; Customer Care – registering, licensing and general account queries; data Recovery – receiving and repairing / recovering corrupt customer data.

3.7 Software installation and support

TAS Books products are sold directly by TAS via advertising, though various accounting and business partners in practice, through national and independent resellers and by national retailers. Instructions in the Quick Start manuals should be sufficient for users to easily install the product themselves. However, some users are assisted with the implementation of the product by their accountants.

TAS also provides classroom training and one to one on-site training.

3.8 Partner network and related accreditation process

TAS has a network for Accountants in practice and Resellers who use and promote TAS Books products. There is no formal accreditation process.

4.0 Evaluation Conclusion

There were no areas in the evaluation that gave concern. TAS Books for Accountants Version 8 is a well designed package for accountants and bookkeepers that has been competently written and are sold and supported by TAS Software directly. The combined ledger design incorporating Sales Ledger, Purchase Ledger and General Ledger gives flexibility and accuracy with a facility to print-out complete audit trails and reports as required.

The software allows accounts and bookkeepers to import and update client data sets from all levels of TAS Books as well as creating new data sets as required. In provides the same functionality as the equivalent level of the TAS Books product
