




UK Payments

Chart 1.1 Payment volumes (millions) 2009 to 2019






Are crypto-assets 'money'?


FUNCTION OF MONEY	WHAT IT MEANS	CRYPTO
Medium of exchange	Money allows goods and services to be traded without the need for a barter system.	
Store of value	An asset whose "value" can be used now or used in the future - its value can be retrieved at a later date.	
Unit of account	This allows the value of something to be expressed in an understandable way, and in a way that allows the value of items to be compared.	
Standard of deferred payment	This is the expressing of the value of a debt i.e. if people borrow today, then they can pay back their loan in the future in a way that is acceptable to the person who made the loan.
